

Electronic Resources on the Internet:

Electronic Journals

There are a number of natural history journals available in the internet. Some have only the table on content, some have an abstract of the articles and some include the full text of the article available.

This document lists some of the journals which are available on the internet, and the period for which they are available. The first section is a list of journals which are available free on the internet.

The second section is a list of journals available through a group called *Informit*. Although the full text of articles is available through *Informit*, **there is a charge**, but a proportion of that charge is returned to the publisher.
