



Demonstration on using the iNaturalist phone app




When you open the phone app you will see a screen with your observations & stats (if any).


This is my observation list.



Choose the tiles, top left of the screen, and you should then get a drop down list of options, choose the bottom option, "New Observation"




You'll then get the option to "Take Photo" – or if you already have an image on phone then "Choose Image"




Take a photo & if satisfied with quality etc then click "OK"




When you select "OK" the app will open this screen. With plants it is helpful to have more than 1 photo so I have then selected the Camera icon, taken another photo




After taking another photo, this time a close up of the flower and again selecting "Ok" from the camera screen, the app then returns to this screen, now showing both images



Select
“What did you see”



And the app will give you a list of possible IDs for your observation. Most times I would select the genus, family or even a higher level but here I know it is *Y japonica* so I click on the “tick”



The app then takes you back to this screen with the name you have selected showing. At this point you can add “Notes” about your observation





The **date & time**  is automatic from phone or camera
The **location**  is automatic, provided you have location turned on and linked to your phone camera.

Location Visibility  is “open” by default. If the observation is on private land you can select “Obscured” or “Private”.


captive or cultivated  select this box for plants that have been imported or animals that are not roaming free.

Then select the green tick



You'll then get a message advising your observation is being uploaded and synced.

Depending on internet speed at your location your observation will be uploaded within a minute or so if in the city, or if out in the bush many minutes. You might have to wait until you return to "civilization" before the upload is complete.



Once uploaded your screen will revert back to the home screen you had at the start but now with your new observation showing.

If you are in area with limited or No internet access it would be helpful if before you start recording observations you go to the tile icon (top left on screen) then click “settings” option and then untick “Automatic Upload”. Once back in good range click/ tick “Automatic Upload” and any observations will be uploaded.
